Santa Rosa Memorial Hospital is a Catholic not-for-profit, full-service health care facility committed to caring for the Sonoma community, including our most vulnerable residents. Santa Rosa Memorial Hospital is the designated Level II Regional Trauma Center for Sonoma, Mendocino, Napa and Lake Counties. The hospital's scope of services includes: acute rehab, cancer, cardiac, critical care, women's and children's services, neuro, orthopedics, outpatient surgery, pediatrics and much more. The hospital is a Joint Commission designated Advanced Primary Stroke Center and home to the Norma & Evert Person Heart & Vascular Institute and the UCSF Neonatal Intensive Care Nursery.

Since its inception in 1950, Santa Rosa Memorial Hospital has continued to extend its role in the community far beyond the traditional medical model. For the past 69 years, we've partnered with schools, community groups, and local organizations to extend our care beyond our walls and meet the changing needs of all who make their home in Sonoma County.
