Petaluma Valley Hospital is an 80-bed acute care hospital operated by St. Joseph Health. Petaluma Valley Hospital offers 24 hour emergency and outpatient services, including a Family Birth Center, Respiratory Therapy, Telemetry, Pulmonary Rehabilitation and Critical Care.

St. Joseph Health is committed to extending its role in the community far beyond the traditional medical model. For more than 20 years, we've partnered with schools, community groups and national organizations to extend our care beyond our walls and meet the changing needs of all who make their home in Petaluma, including our most vulnerable neighbors.

Through programs like Healthy 4 Life, we have helped prevent childhood obesity through physical activity and healthy eating. Through our House Calls program, we have provided home care to seniors with chronic diseases who have limited mobility, insurance or funds.

Through these programs, and others, St. Joseph Health reinvested more than \$24.5 million into the Petaluma community to care for the poor, vulnerable, low income, uninsured and underinsured in Fiscal Year 2017.
